### MINISTRY FOR TOMORROW UPDATE

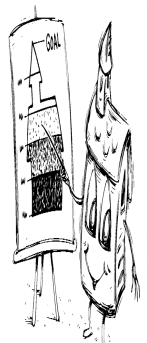
Many thanks to all who made the Reunion Weekend such a success. It truly was a celebration of our Past, Present and Future Ministries.
