BUILDING UPDATE

Progress is being made on our building repairs. The first phase of repairs has been focused on cleaning.

The air ducts throughout the building have been cleaned. In the Narthex, the small sacristy beneath the stairs has been demolished and the area cleaned. In the Nave, the main sacristy has been remediated and cleaned, and the Nave ceiling has been remediated. With the cleaning work finished, phase one of our building repair is now complete.

Phase two will focus on reconstruction and will begin shortly.
