July 13, 2026 – Door Code Access Reset

Thank you to everyone who has taken the time to complete the online training and gotten a new code. There are many of you (who've done the training) who still need to come to the office to get a new code (everyone with an old code needs to get a new code). **Old codes will be erased on July 13th.**

Old code = codes assigned before June 1, 2026

If it turns out you can't get into the building after July 13th, please follow the instructions below to get a new code that will work.

To get a new code, you will need to:

- **Complete** the required online Safe Church courses
 - Limited Access Code (used by group members; works on select days, ex. Thursdays from 6:30-8:30 p.m.)
 - All Access Code (works 24/7; used by Vestry, Staff, PRC, Group Leads, etc.)
- **Email your transcript** to Emily in the church office
- **Visit the office** to fill out a (yellow) form and get a new code



If you have any physical keys, be sure to bring them with you so they can either be turned in or checked out again.
