If you are still working on your Safe Church training to receive a new door code, here's what you need to know:

- **Complete** the required online Safe Church courses:
 - Limited Access Code (2 classes; used by group members; works on select days, ex. Thursdays from 6:30-8:30 p.m.)
 - All Access Code (9 classes; works 24/7; used by Vestry, Staff, PRC, Group Leads, etc.)
- **Email your transcript** to Emily in the church office
- **Visit the office** to fill out a (yellow) form and get a new code
